- Provides supervision of students who attend the alt learning site.
- Plans daily instructional activities, lesson plans that correlate with student needs.
- Supports and guide the educational assistants working one on one with students.
- Conducts appropriate academic assessments for students when needed. (Running Records, Key Math, Writing, and Daily Formative assessments that guides planning.) Submits data to the school and completes quarterly progress reports and or report cards. Reports to the Principal.
- Maintains student records and files in a confidential manner.
- Utilizes student's IEP and Eastern Door reports to help guide instruction and the implementation of school related recommendations.
- Works collaboratively and communicates with the parents, educational assistant, school, specialists, and Eastern door on an as needed basis.
- Demonstrates a high degree of professionalism and ethics, working cooperatively with the parents, educational assistant, school, specialists, Eastern Door and students.

- Has an understanding of how to support students with complex multiple needs and can manage difficult behaviour; has great classroom management skills.
- Is able to think outside the box and apply non tradition ways of teaching into the daily lesson when needed.
